Good evening teams,

While this news will be confirmed in the next Rule Book update, we wanted to get you this information as quickly as possible.

Following last Wednesday's test session which saw the Dallara DW-12 serve in a Veterans 100 race package, the sanctioning body has decided to move forward with this package for the 2020 race. That means the Dallara DW-12 will be the car for the Veterans 100 this year, running a fixed setup with adjustments that will create similar speeds and handling characteristics to the current-generation Indy Lights chassis.

We appreciate the exciting finish the Formula Renault 3.5 chassis produced last year, but it is the sanctioning body's opinion that a more authentic "Freedom 100" experience can be produced with the Dallara DW-12, which is why we are moving forward with the updated chassis.
