Good morning teams,

As you may know, RaceSpot TV will be providing final-hour (5 PM ET) coverage of both Pole Day (November 7) and Bump Day (November 8) qualifications. With that, any driver who wishes to have their livery shown on the RaceSpot TV broadcast must submit their .TGA files to the DropBox link below.

All liveries must adhere to the iRacing Paint Policy, and if you are utilizing any logos that aren't already available in the iRacing Paint Shop (excluding Chevrolet and Honda – we have permission from them for all entries), then you must also attach sponsor permissions for those brands as well. If you have a custom helmet and suit that you would like shown on-air as well, it must also be posted at the DropBox link.

LIVERIES MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 5 TO MAKE THE QUALIFICATIONS BROADCAST.

LIVERIES MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 12 TO MAKE THE RACE WEEKEND BROADCAST.

You only need to submit your paint files once – submissions during qualifications week will carry over to race week. Those deadlines listed above are also available in the Entrant Schedule posted in Discord and on Open-Wheels.com in our participant section.
