Rundown of topics for Sunday, November 1 driver's meeting:

- Practice Procedures
 - Attendance at practice is recommended; opportunity to get sponsors on-air and work around 2020 drivers for the event
 - Try to practice correct pit road procedures.
 - If you crash with substantial damage, exit car immediately. Do not drive around
 - Drivers off the pace – use access roads to avoid traffic. Be courteous.
 - Tanner will not be monitoring voice chat during practice. Use text chat to ask questions in-sim.
- Qualifications Procedures
 - READ THE RULE BOOK. We will send a bulletin before qualifying weekend with an overview of qualifying rules, but it is YOUR responsibility to know.
 - New for 2020 – there is no 200 MPH rule. Only 60 second rule on out lap.
 - Do not leave the pit lane without my instruction. This may result in a penalty.
 - Track only opens for practice under my instruction.
 - For the Group 1 and Group 2 sessions on Saturday, make sure you enter the correct session. If you enter the incorrect session, you risk losing a qualifications attempt. All subsequent sessions are open for all participants.
 - Also for Group 1/2 sessions, make sure to arrive at least 30 minutes beforehand
 - Same behavior from practice expected during quals – especially for the 5:00 PM Eastern broadcasts by RaceSpot on Pole Day and Bump Day.
- Race weekend and Veterans 100/PSC procedures will be discussed on Saturday, Nov. 14
